CALL TO ORDER Board President David Williams called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m., leading the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

On motion of President David Williams and seconded by Director Brandon Hunt and approved by those present, the Board approved the consent calendar. 3 ayes. 1 absent. 1 vacant.

Manager's Report

- A. Advised Board the PFAS testing at Well 1 was completed and results returned as non-detected.
- B. Advised Board Arsenic testing at Well 3 exceeded the maximum contaminant level. We advised our state regulator and they requested we retest. They will then take an average of the two results and advise of next steps – to stay on regular testing or require quarterly testing for a length of time. Results were received at an acceptable level of 9.3. We have advised the state regulator and we are waiting for further instruction.

- C. Advised Board that several surrounding water districts were contacted to confirm whether or not they charge fire departments for water usage. The research concluded that fire departments are not charged for water usage, but counties are charged for any water used by the public works departments. It was decided that SCSD would continue to charge any parties who hook up to our hydrant to obtain water, including the county.
- D. Advised Board of three leaks on services lines this past month. Discussed details and challenges of the valves and distribution lines.
- E. Advised Board one employee is out on paternity leave and will be taking allotted time in incremental time periods so that he can still assist with keeping the workflow up to date.
- F. Advised Board Sutter CSD staff met with Sanbell to review the plans. They addressed our questions and we will continue moving forward and be in contact with the state and other agencies regarding funding options.
- G. Advised Board Tesco's annual maintenance visit is scheduled for July 7, 2026.

Discussion & Action Item

- A. Dane Wadle of California Special District Association rescheduled his presentation.
- B. Board member candidates Allan Brown and Branch Rickey made introductions and stated their qualifications and desire to be appointed to the SCSD Board as a Director.
- C. Advised Board candidate filing window at the Elections office begins on July 13 and needs to be completed by August 7.
- D. The Board discussed the candidates for Director, and it was agreed that a Special Meeting would be held on July 13, 2026 at 5:30 to further discuss and make the appointment for the Director. There was one Director absent at the July 6, 2026 meeting and Board President Williams requested the Special Meeting so that all four current members could be present for the vote.
